

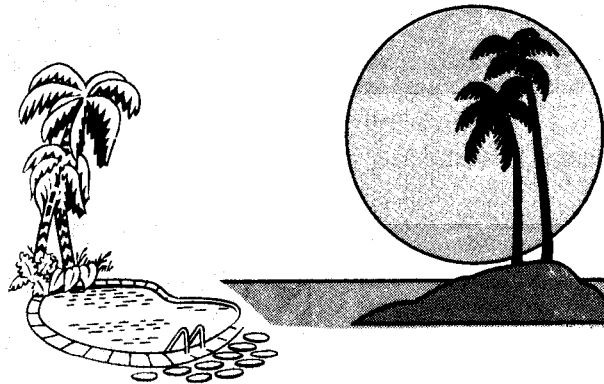

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT


Your support is needed and appreciated.

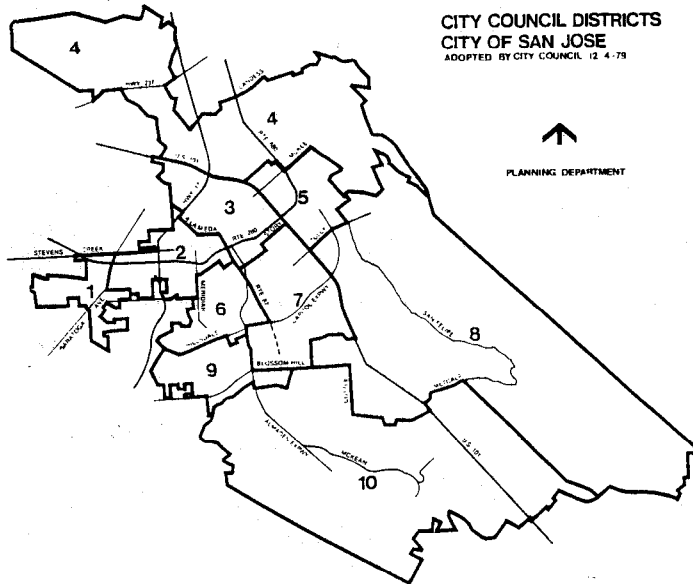

CITY OF SAN JOSE
ADOPTED BY CITY COUNCIL 12-4-75



Office uses are proposed at Chynoweth and Pearl, rather than High and Medium High Density Residential as now planned, and Medium High Density Residential is requested on a westerly portion of Communications Hill.

The Los Gatos Golf Course is again proposed for residential use. Significant urban service area expansions are requested in the Santa Teresa Hills, the hills south of Calero Reservoir, and in the Coyote Valley along Bailey Road.

High Density Residential is requested for the Cypress Greens Golf Course and a portion of the adjacent Pleasant Hills Golf Course, and Medium High Density Residential is proposed on 55 acres near Quimby and Chaboya. Several requests for major urban service expansions are on file, including Richmond Ranch - East, and in the Silver Creek Hills for a golf course, Residential, Commercial and Industrial Park uses.

The easterly portion of the Cambrian Golf Course site is again proposed for Medium High Density Residential use, and a portion of the Hogue School property is also under request for Medium High Density Residential.

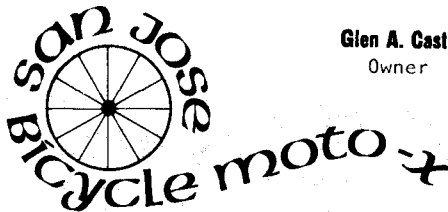

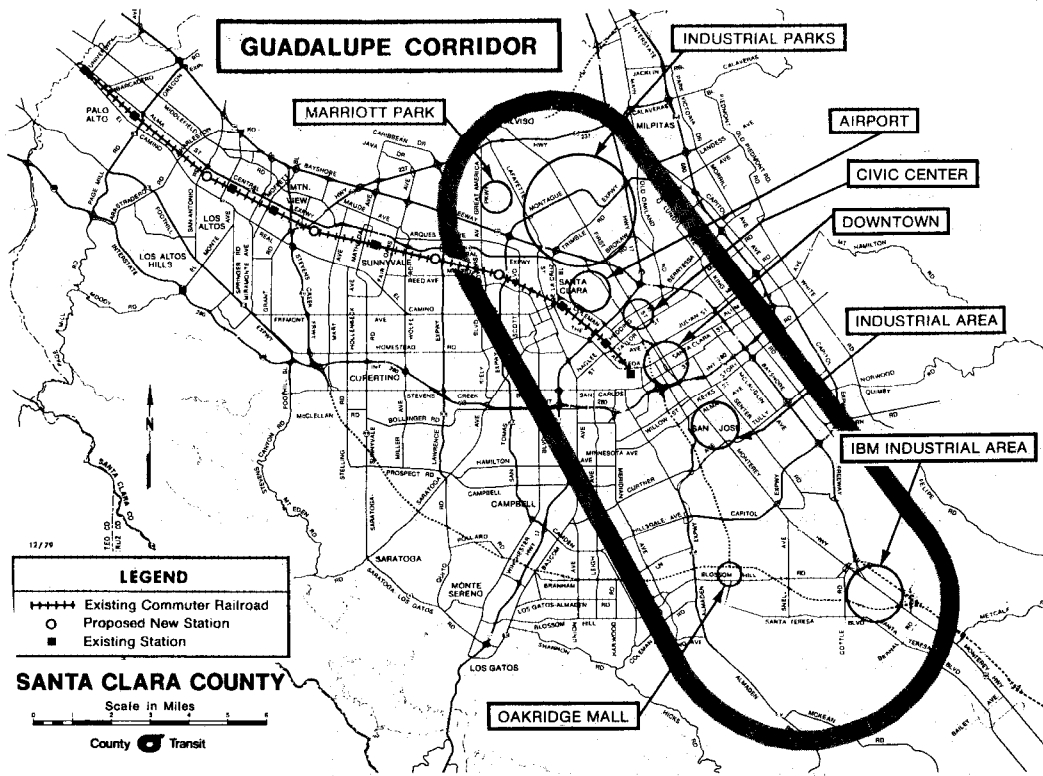
